What is CAP?

Common Admission process or CAP is the final selection round comprising Personal Interview (PI) and Writing Ability Test (WAT) for MBA admission 2022 in new IIMs. CAP 2022 is likely to be conducted in the month of February-March 2022 by one of the new IIMs. Last year it was conducted by IIM Raipur.

Participating IIMs in CAP 2022

The CAP 2022 selection process consists of two components - Writing Ability Test (WAT) and Personal Interview (PI) round. CAP 2022 is a single point selection process and is common PI-WAT round for all the participating IIMs. It is conducted in prominent cities of India. Candidates are not required to separately appear in PI-WAT for each of the participating IIMs as the scores of CAP are applicable for all the participating IIMs. Final admission offer to the candidates is released by the new IIMs based on the performance in CAP round, CAT score, Academic Profile, diversity, work experience among other parameters.

The CAP round is organized for the IIMs which started operation in 2010-11 and for the new generation IIMs that started operating in 2015-16. It is the final selection round comprising common PI-WAT process for following 9 IIMs which participated in CAP last year:

How CAP was conducted Last year?

The whole process was conducted online. There was no WAT round, only PI took place. Read CAT toppers experiences on Online PI round for new and baby IIMs CAP.

What does the IIMs look for?

- Excellent Academic Background

- Work Experience is a great asset
- Knowledge base is of utmost importance
- Personal Interview Evaluates Candidates on Qualities of – Focus, Clarity of Thought, Learnability, Level of Optimism, Ability to handle pressure, Decision making skills, Discipline

Prerequisite

- Form to be Submitted (Interview)
- Resume (not mentioned , good to carry)
- Original Documents along with photocopies

Insights - Interview

Interview time - 20-30 Minutes. (Sometimes as low as 10 mints)

Interview Panel Details - Only 2 people (One Professor and One Alumni or two professors, earlier it used to be 3-4 Panelists)

Interview Type - Detailed Interviews check your through knowledge of subjects (Companies) / Decent knowledge of Current Affairs

Interview discussion Pointers –

- Be completely prepared with anything and everything on the form.
- They will go into details of everything you speak about in the interview. (level1- what do you know about Indian Economy level2- what do you think about GST, level3- how has GST affected the sector you work in).
- They will test your knowledge base and approach to problems
- It is absolutely fine to ask for time before you answer (they often expect you to think about a solution when they ask you about a problem at hand).
- It is fine if you are anxious and you need not portray a brave face being real with your emotions is better.
- Be prepared to answer everything about you work experience or about your favorite subjects if you are a fresher.

I decided to attend this as a trial run in the lead up to my B interview on 14th Feb.

There were three panelists, 2 female and one male. Let's call the females F1 and F2 and male M1. G is me.

M1: Tell me something about yourself.

G: My name is Ganesh. Ever since I was a child, I was very taken by books. This started because of my parents who consistently brought a lot of books home. Also, being an only child, books were among my only entertainment. When I read these books, I started empathizing with the characters. I started understanding different types of people. Fast forward to IIT Hyderabad, and this empathy and understanding are what motivated me to take up several extracurriculars, where I could effectively understand and communicate with people. Carrying forward my interest, I founded the literary society at IITH. It was a very bleak literary scene that we started at and then we went on to win the best club award for the year. My stint at the Entrepreneurship cell made me interested in companies. And it was this mix of extracurriculars and academics that motivated me to take up a techno management job at BPCL. And working at BPCL, at the refinery, I felt that my job was too specific and less based on problem solving. Which is what led me to write CAT this year.

F1: You said you founded the litsoc. Wasn't it already there? What activities did you conduct?

G: IITH started only in 2008. There was a literary activities club that had done very poorly and was shelved. Then I integrated the debate club, the literary activities club and the quiz club into one.

F1: Your favorite author from fiction and non-fiction

G: JK Rowling is an all-time favorite. JRR Tolkien as well. I've read very little nonfiction but the book "Zen and the art of motorcycle maintenance" was something that I could associate very deeply with. Even though it was an abstract read, the story of Phcdrus echoed very strongly with me

F1: Favorite character from LOTR.

G: Gandalf

M1: You're a mechanical engineer. Tell me the Different operations that happen on a lathe.

G: turning. That is the basic operation to reduce the diameter of a job. Then there's facing. In order to make a surface planar and clean. If there's an end Chuck, we can bore and drill the job. By setting the insert at an angle, we can chamfer a job. Then we can use special inserts to give the job a texture. (Knurling-couldn't recall it then) M1: what is the Difference between a NC and CNC machine.

G: Sir, I've never worked on an NC machine but I think a CNC machine has storage ability while an NC machine can only execute one command after another. Hence we cannot have NC programs but a CNC machine can be used to run programs.

M1: What area have you specialized in?

G: there's no specialization as such, but I've worked a little on solid mechanics and materials

F1: So, tell me, what is your key takeaway from budget

G: A lot of people are now talking about the healthcare policy that the government is touting. In fact, yesterday, I was reading that there have been no exact fund allocations for the plan, but the government

would raise the amount as and when needed. That aside, I think this is a valuable step in the right direction for a country like India, since medical care is also a necessity that the government should take care of. And by starting such a program, it is making a positive stride towards healthcare, something that should have been done long ago. While this isn't the first time that such an effort is being made and a similar plan happened in 1980s, when the government couldn't execute it because of the poor condition of the Indian economy, we find ourselves in a similar state now, where the economy isn't as healthy. But this plan if executed would be a great step in the right direction.

F2: Do you think our economy is slowing down. What are the indications that you use for this?

G: The large amounts of NPAs with Banks is making the money unavailable to the public. Because when people don't repay loans, the lending capacity of the bank decreases. When the lending capacity decreases, people spend lesser. It is like the repo and reverse repo rates. If the RBI lends at cheaper rate, the bank lend at cheaper rates and there is more cash flow. When cash is stuck like this, there is less spending. And since GDP is based on spending, the growth of the GDP also slows down.

F1: What steps should the government take for Improvements in the farm sector? Are subsidies effective?

G: India is a heavily farm agriculture-based economy. While the trend of the government has always been giving subsidies on farm equipment, the latest budget increased the MSP. While subsidies do encourage more farm production, I do think that MSP increase is also essential as it provides a cushion for the farmer in the last stage of production. The biggest problem with India is subsistence-based agriculture. With inheritance, the area of lands are being divided which is leading to increased fixed costs and lesser production. The government should invest in farm infrastructure to support initiatives like ladder farming and greenhouses in order to increase production. They shouldn't go for blind subsidies in fertilizers as they leech the ground in the long run.

F1: Why MBA?

G: like I said earlier, I have been interested in problem solving since I was a child. I like to dissect the problem, analyze it and solve it. I think that though I'm able to apply my technical knowledge at BPCL, I couldn't really concentrate on components that involved large scale problem solving. The scope of the job is clearly defined for me and I would like to move to a more strategic profile- I'm not really sure if strategy is exactly what my opinion about it is, but I seem to be inclined towards it.

F2: Don't you face any problems in your company?

G: no ma'am, we sure do. In industries like ours, there are periodic turnaround activities where we have to carry out a set of jobs in an extremely limited timeframe. That aspect involves a lot of problem solving but the shutdowns are only for few days of the year. The rest of the year, the job has limited challenges and the work carried out is often easily manageable.

F1: Are there any women on the shop floor?

G: No ma'am. A few trade apprentices, but no one else. The factory act 1950 doesn't allow women to work in a factory after 7pm. And maintenance department often requires overtime, which takes it to around 11pm on a few days. Since they wouldn't be allowed to do that, there are very few women on the shop floor.

F1: very few or no women?

G: no women, but there are a couple of officers in the electrical department.

Then applied for Advance PG course for Diploma in Advanced Computing in CDAC ACTS in August 2018. Got placed in Nokia. Worked in Nokia for 2 years 7 months, I explained my role in an elaborated way .

Me:

Some hardcore techie stuff, but they weren't seemed interested.

Interviewer- Why your grades and CGPA in college very low?

Me: I said I got good grades in 10th and 12th because I worked consistently there but in college I tried working on last week of exam and could never able to get grades based on extempore preparation

Interviewer- But then you will again have to work hard in IIM and study, won't you fear you will again fail, working hard.

Me: Sir, this was in 2013–17 phase and now I have evolved much. At that time I wasn't sure should I be working in technical or Civil Services but yes after 4–5 years now, the picture seems quite perfect. I am now working in technical domain for 3 years and if you see my CDAC grades, there was a gradual improvement.

(Male Interviewer didn't seemed convinced. He was in a hurry to wrap things up)

Male Interviewer- Okay Rajeev, you tell us 3 good things about your hometown and 3 weaknesses.

Me: I belong to Amritsar. industry wise this isn't much suited for employment. Amritsar is mainly based on tourism. People from all over the world come and visit Kashmir + Amritsar circuit. Other good thing is the cuisines of Amritsar. There are certain hotspots which only a local person would know. So tourism wise, it is good.

Amritsar hasn't been able to produce much jobs so we see many youth going to abroad or Canada. One industry I see booming in Amritsar is the IELTS , GMAT coaching industry. Everyone here is looking to go abroad.

Industry wise - Punjab is mainly an agrarian economy. Punjab led the green revolution in 1966 for wheat procurement and hence called the wheat bowl of India, but ever since then it has always been labour intensive and not capital intensive. Now today in 2022 ,along with Punjab, Madhya Pradesh and Western UP is also leading producers of wheat. Punjab hasn't been able to keep its industry up to the 21st century mark.

Partly the problem has been the political structure which is very much chaotic right now.

Interviewer: Can you explain us the 3 pros and cons of Farming in Punjab?

Me: The pros are with 3 farm laws - all farmers will come under government data and this sector would be more organised. If private sector comes in arrangement with the farmers, it would be good for any external shocks for contracts. Cons is that , private sector can use it for their benefit

The cons of the farm laws is that people aren't sure about its outcomes. There is an extensive network of APMC, Mandis which they fear will be removed.

M Interviewer- Farmers not rotating crops, and some cancer related problems in Bathinda, aren't these the problems? What are your views on it?

Me: Yes, agreed 100%. Ours is the only state where Electricity is given free to farmers for irrigation purposes, for vote banks and MSP will be gone is also a concern and our water table is also dropping. Substances like Mercury are added and hence its causing cancers, so yeah this is alarming.

Interviewer: So what are your achievements? Anything you have played, worked in NGO?

Me: Sir I like Chess very much.

Interviewer: No no, I mean any achievement you have got

Me: Sir ,I like to travel.

Interviewer: No Rajeev, you are not understanding the question. I am not asking about your hobbies, have you played anything like badminton, Tennis?

Two male professors P1 and P2:

P1: Tell me some good things about yourself.

I was overprepared for the "introduce yourself" question and it also was my first interview. I started going along that lines, but then apologized and told a few things related to my research background. (Not a good start).

P1: So, you are currently in Pune?

No, currently at ICTS Bangalore. I am doing my MS research project here for one year.

P1: Will you leave your current education if you get selected?

No, I would have finished my master's by then.

P1: It is really a dream for a physics student to study at IISER and ICTS. Don't you think it is very stupid to do an MBA?

Yes, it is prestigious. Then, a well-rehearsed answer.

P1: Why don't you do some other form of research if you are not interested in academia? (from my previous answer, where I said that I did want to continue in academia)

Anticipated, answered.

P1: Skills that you learned in research that will be useful in your MBA?

Analytical and quantitative, modelling, presentation. (told an experience related to my internship for support).

P2: Tell me an application of theoretical physics in everyday life?

Photoelectric effect and solar energy.

P2: You gave an example of impactful research, but earlier you said that research work is of scholarly interest for a long time and has no immediate tangible impact. (answer of why not research)

I said definitely research is impactful and over a considerable amount of time, it will show its impact on society. But, as a researcher, only 1 out of your 100 works will go into creating such an impact. I did not want to spend my energy that way. (He was satisfied).

P2: So whatever you learned till now is useless now?

Technical knowledge – yes. But, I think the education gives a right attitude and other soft skills which helps you excel throughout your life. (of course, this is just the outline of my answer, I was formal in my sentences).

P2: Why do you think that in India, we feel apologetic about admitting that we are doing MBA for money? what are your views on this culture?

I said a few things like if it is the only thing that you are looking for then you won't be able to enjoy the learning process. So, it is good to have the right attitude. Having said that, money is an important factor in most of our decisions and there should not be any shame in admitting that. But, if you be blatant about it in an interview, then you might not be perceived very positively.
