
Interview time - 20-30 Minutes. (Sometimes as low as 10 mints)

Interview Panel Details - 2 to 3 people (Professor and Alumni)

Interview Type - Detailed Interviews check your perspective, thought process, interests and knowledge

Interview discussion Pointers – (as per IIM experiences of last five years)

- Be completely prepared with anything and everything on the form.
- They will go into details of everything you speak about in the interview. (level1- what do you know about Indian Economy level2- what do you think about GST, level3- how has GST affected the sector you work in).
- They can ask about your hobbies and interests.
- It is absolutely fine to ask for time before you answer (they often expect you to think about a solution when they ask you about a problem at hand).
- It is fine if you are anxious and you need not portray a brave face. Being real with your emotions is better.
- Be prepared to answer everything about your work experience or about your favorite subjects if you are a fresher.

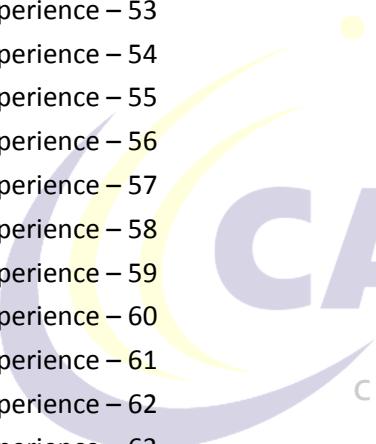

They asked me why I switched so many jobs [i switched only 1 and 1 is a promotion that they realised in a sec] i told i like to learn sir, in startups its very fast paced.

M2: You have a lot of hobbies

M1: Tell me about Mountain trekking,

I talked about how karnataka is full of mountains and i did trek 3 of them and i explained the height of the mountains and names

M1: Tell me the management aspects of mountains trekking :

I told Packing and Organising

Budgeting

Optimising on root

Collaboration.

M2 : told me some term for packing : I don't recall and I said i'm an amateur trekker not a professional.

M1 : What's 7P's of marketing

Answered.

M1: whats 4 c's of Marketing

Told 3 and [Forgot the last c]

Told sorry I cannot recall the last c.

M1: Take the Mentos and explain the 7 p's of this product .

I explained 4, they stopped and corrected something I said okay and did not prolong with justification.

They asked me what's the process and physical evidence in them,

I told Physical evidence is how the business is impacting socially and focusing on sustainability

Process is : how supply chain and other processes of manufacturing work.

Cross questioned and explained in between,

Asked me about work ex:

What did you work as in the first company position :

I said sales and revenue operations , data analytics and explained the processes and teams,

M2 : so you summarise data he said ,

i said yes, of 200 sales agents and their performance metrics.and also Supply chain data,

M2: cross questioned on that and suggested some alternative for which i realised its irrelevant but I did not correct him

M1: which tools ?

I told google sheets and excel with tableau sometimes

Then,

M2 : Tell me all the steps involved in the product development of a product, told me to wriitedown

I did and he cross questioned and told i missed some points , i told i wrote it in a general product way not in terms of any specific product structure [Both tech and physical]

M2: Asked me Mean, Median, Mode and told me from 1-10 numbers , what is the mean, median and mode

Asked me Standard differentiation or something, i told i'm not aware of it sir,

I took a second and wrote the Mean and Median of 1-10 but i was not sure about mode and i explained what's mode and told i don't know mode of this , cause they are all unique numbers.

Asked me if mean and average the same thing ;

I told pretty much the same thing sir,

M2 cross questioned telling : Can you tell me Average or mean of this room , I told it would be the mid point i think sir i'm not sure,

M2: told mean or average as it's a cuboid ,

I told mean,

There is a difference, right ?

I told yes without clarity.

They told give the documents of work ex and extra curricular certificates :
I asked why Byju's experience is not mentioned, I told the docs were not available at that time so I did not submit.

They said okay, and gave back, asked if i had all of them and once i got all of them, they told me to change the card they have given and leave,
I thanked and left.

They were having a conversation rather than an interview. Its pretty chill if you are going in with a peace of mind. I was smiling throughout.

F: What was the political climate during the implementation of the 1991 LPG reforms?

Me: Started talking about the balance of payments crisis, how India had exchange reserves for only imports of only two weeks...

M: No, no...that's not the political climate.

Me: Talked about Rajiv Gandhi's assassination in 1991; implementation of the recommendations of the Mandal Commission; drumming up support of the Ramjanambhoomi movement.

F: Were the successive governments able to carry on the LPG reforms?

Me: Talked about how the Vajpayee government introduced an entire disinvestment ministry, and opened up more sectors for private companies.

M: Okay, tell us something about the economic reforms in the last five years.

Me: Starts talking about the amended Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code...

M: No, no. That's not an economic reform.

Me: Starts talking about the increase in capital expenditure...

M (somewhat miffed): Again, that's not an economic reform.

Me: Talks about the disinvestment of Air India.

M: Yes, that's an economic reform. What else?

Me: Talks about the PLI and FAME schemes.

F: What is the downside of the PLI scheme?

Me: Talks about how the true efficacy of the PLI scheme will take years to compute. There's always fear of industries renegeing because of the current recessionary environment.
